Video analysis: The purpose of the video analysis assignment is to encourage you to listen to and think about the first-person perspectives on individuals with emotional-behavioral disorders.

In our first class session on the topic of *attention deficit hyperactivity disorder*, we watched Stephen Tonti's TED Talk on living with ADHD: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=uU6o2_UFSEY. For this video analysis assignment, re-watch the Stephen Tonti video. Next, search online to identify one additional 1st-person video narrative from an individual with ADHD. Write a 300-500 word essay (approximately 2-3 pages double-spaced) that a) summarizes the perspectives of *each* speaker, and b) compares/contrasts their viewpoints. Include *direct references* (e.g., page numbers and supporting quotations) to the course textbook or other materials you found online that support your analyses.
